

EDPA Pre-Certification Checklist

1. Education & Apprenticeship Documentation
 Dental School Certificate of Completion OR Completed Apprenticeship Form(s) from your supervising mentor(s) Apprenticeship Time Reporting Sheets – Minimum 80 hours post-schooling Letters of Recommendation:
2 from clients
 2 from veterinarians (at least 1 must be from your case supervising veterinarian)
2. Photographed Case Studies (4 Required)
Photo Requirements:
 Clear, color photos with complete arcades and a clean oral cavity
 Label each photo with Horse Name and "Before" or "After"
• Format: Before/After side-by-side or separate pages for all Before and all After photos
Review the SAMPLE PHOTOS PAGE for required angles
1 case: 2–10 years old1 case: 11–20 years old1 case: 20+ years old1 case: Applicant's choice
Required Photo Angles:
Incisors: Left, Right, Central
Open view of 100/200 arcades
Open view of 300 arcade
Open view of 400 arcade
*Even untreated areas require After photos
Case Documentation: Completed chart for each horse, signed by supervising veterinarian(s) Supervising Veterinarian Evaluation Form for each horse, signed
3. Work History Log
20 completed case charts – detailed and accurate
Include sedation notes from owner or supervising veterinarian

Include contact information for owner and supervising veterinarian

Signed by mentor/veterinarian reviewing your work
